How to use your Passport to Learning

You will use your Passport to Learning to record all the learning destination activities that you complete. Remember you are collecting these learning stamps as you are working towards a Children's University National Award.

- If you are visitng a Learning Destination take your Passport to Learning with you. You can find a list of Learning Destinations on the website www.suffolkchildrensuniversity.co.uk
- When you have finished your visit/activity, ask the learning activity provider to sign your Passport to Learning. Don't worry if they can't sign it, we can organise that at school too.

- Completing a CU Challenge: As well as being able to visit learning destinations, you can complete any of our CU Challenges and your school will be able to award your Learning Stamps into your Passport once they have seen your completed challenge.
- You can also record your involvement with after school clubs too and your club leader will help you to complete the entry into your Passport.

Top Tip!

When you complete a page of learning stamps, add the total of hours and make a note at the bottom of the page. It will make is simpler to add all your hours together before a CU Graduation.
